5. What is your Trade or Calling? ... *Col. Gen.*
6. Are you Married? ... *No*
7. Have you ever served in any branch of His Majesty's Forces, naval or military, if so, which? ... *No*
8. Are you willing to be vaccinated or re-vaccinated? ... *Yes*
9. Are you willing to be enlisted for general service? ... *Yes*
10. Did you receive a Notice, and do you understand its meaning, and who gave it to you? ... *Yes* Name *Robert Brown Scott* Corps *General*
11. Are you willing to serve upon the following conditions provided His Majesty should so long require your services? ... *Yes*

For the duration of the War, at the end of which you will be discharged with all convenient speed. If employed with His Majesty's troops or in His Majesty's service, you may be retained after the termination of the war, if your services can be spared, but such retention shall in no case exceed six months.

The Recruit above named was cautioned by me that if he made any false answer to any of the above questions, he would be liable to be punished as provided in the Army Act.
